

April 2013 Meeting Minutes

Hi Neighbors,

Our first WSW meeting of the year was a very productive one.

Evan Richert from the Ad Hoc committee was in attendance. The proposed revitalization changes were discussed in great detail. Evan was very informative and responsive to questions and concerns from the group. The next community meeting for the Revitalization will be Thursday, May 23rd at the Doughty School at 5:30 pm.

Also discussed was the passing of the Sex offender residency restrictions. This ordinance bans some sex offenders from moving to within 750 feet of a publicly owned property frequented by children. The residency restriction applies to individuals convicted of Class A, B or C sex offenses committed against a child under age 14. Offenders in that category who live within a 750-foot boundary won't be required to move. However, if they did move, their residence would have to be outside the restricted zone, and they could not move back into a restricted area.

Attached is a Map that David put together of what the 750' covers within our community.

The Green lines are 750' from Property Line of 2nd St Park, the one red from the park is from the edge of the bark mulch area of the playground to the property line for the homeless shelter, that's only 702'

The other red lines are all 750' from the schools.

Our next WSW meeting will be on Tuesday, May 21st from 6PM to 8PM. We will go over the items discussed at last night meeting. Our goal is to put our ideas together and present a uniform presence at the community meeting being held on May 23rd.
