The Greek community began the construction of St. George Greek Orthodox Church in November 1929 on a small plot of land on what is now the quiet and quaint Sanford Street. It was dedicated Sept. 7, 1930. St. George is the only Eastern Orthodox church in northern Maine. It serves not only the Greek Orthodox population but also the present day congregation includes Russians, Serbians, Ukrainians, Bulgarians, Albanians and other Eastern Orthodox worshippers.

The Greek Orthodox Church has a steep tradition of serving the community. It's actively involved in numerous functions throughout the year including the American Folk Festival held on the Bangor Waterfront.
