

Larkin Street School



Larkin Street Grammar and Intermediate School opened in 1907 and closed in 1968. It was one of the many large brick school houses designed by the well-known Bangor architect Wilfred Mansur.

Beginning in 1969, it served as the warehouse and retail store for the Brown & White Paper Co. until 2008. Bill Masters, a Bangor developer, purchased the building shortly after Brown & White Paper Co. moved out. Mr. Masters rehabilitated the old classrooms into 10 one-bedroom apartments while keeping much of the original oak woodwork, tin ceilings, etc.
